

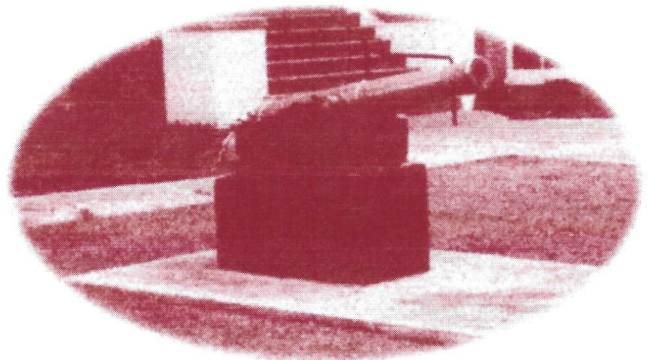

## A NEW BEGINNING

### Message from the President Chamberlain-Hunt Academy “A Ministry of French Camp Academy”

Congratulations to you young men and women in the Class of 1999. You have joined the ranks of a select few in our nation who have earned a diploma from an education institution that has an untouchable heritage.

Today, Chamberlain-Hunt, a Christian Military Academy, continues to live with the visions of Dr. Jeremiah Chamberlain, a staunch Presbyterian minister and founder of Oakland College in 1830, and David Hunt, a wealthy benefactor to the college with a mission of providing young people with the opportunity for an education in a Christian school.

Chamberlain-Hunt Academy began classes in 1879 and was founded as a Christian school by the Presbyterian Church after Oakland College was sold to the state of Mississippi to become what is now known as Alcorn State University. The name Chamberlain-Hunt was selected in memory of Dr. Chamberlain and Mr. Hunt to continue their visions in 1830. Chamberlain-Hunt Academy became a member of the Southern Accreditation Association of Colleges and Secondary Schools in 1911 and has maintained continuous membership.

The 1999 graduating class concludes 120 years of Chamberlain-Hunt Academy. There have been approximately 2500 graduating cadets in addition to thousands of others who attended one or more years. Our Alumni members have continued their education at some of our nations highest recognized institutions and military academies. They have achieved national recognition in many business, professional and military fields.

According to the Board of Trustee minutes of a 1906 meeting, consideration was given by the Presbyterian Church to place both academies under the same management. On April 7, 1998, Chamberlain-Hunt Academy was blessed to be included under the ministry of French Camp Academy, an old Christian school in north Mississippi founded in 1885 by the Presbyterian Church. French Camp Academy is now an independent co-educational Christian Academy. The French Camp Ministry has brought new life to Chamberlain-Hunt by strengthening our spiritual, financial, academic, military and administrative emphasis. I was honored to be elected as the twenty-fourth President of Chamberlain-Hunt Academy.

My personal opinion has always been that any leadership position is bigger than any one person. It requires a team to be successful. That was my reason for creating the “WE TEAM” concept of management. Our team is made up of God and God’s children – you cadets, our staff, and myself. I will forever be grateful to you, the 1999 graduating class, for your support of the team concept.

The year of your graduation is unique from all those before you except for one other year. You are bringing a closure to another century. You have an untouchable heritage of graduating from an academy that has provided an education in a Christian institution to young people in two centuries. You will be the newest class of high school graduates when we enter the third century.

I am confident Chamberlain-Hunt Academy’s excellent staff has given you the spiritual training to resist the worldly temptations; the academic training to be successful in the competitive work world; the leadership to be recognized as a Christian leader; and the ability to be compassionate to all people whatever their station in life.
