Throughout his ten years in Port Gibson, he has actively engaged at ministry among the Cadets and cadre, in the Port Gibson community and in his denomination. He is a born pastor and teacher.



A south Georgia native, MAJ Herrin attended Washington & Lee University, where he earned his BA in history. He continued his history studies at Vanderbilt University, earning an MA. After teaching high school for several years in the Georgia state school system, MAJ Herrin moved to Mississippi to study theology at Reformed Theological Seminary. He earned his MDiv there before accepting the call to be the minister at Port Gibson's Presbyterian Church.


