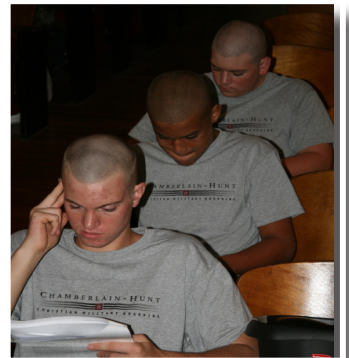


Basic Training
