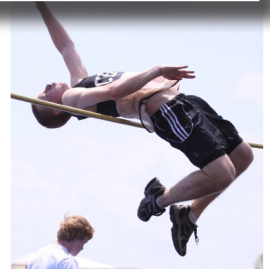
District Track Meet at Chamberlain-Hunt

Cadets receiving upper placement in the competitions were as follows: T. Dowell (MS), J. McNair (MS), N. Looney (TN), and L. Murphy (MS) all placed 1st in the 4x800 Meter Relay; T.

Dowell placed 1st in Discus Throw and 3rd in Pole Vaulting; J. Bonvillian (LA), placed 2nd in the 400 Meter Dash; J. McNair (MS) placed 2nd in the High Jump; S. Kim (Korea), C. Callahan (AR), T. Stark (TX), and J. Bonvillian (LA), all placed 3rd in the 4x400 Meter Relay; and D. Rickels (MS) placed 3rd in Shot Put.
