Welcome MAJ Hartley



Cadre and Cadets welcomed a new face the first day back from the Christmas holiday break: MAJ Kevin Hartley joined us to teach American history and Mississippi history for the 9th through 12th grades.

MAJ Hartley moved here from Antigua in the Caribbean Islands, but calls San Diego, CA his home. He graduated *magna cum laude* from St. Leo University with a bachelor of arts in psychology and religion. Later he earned his master's in religion from Liberty University. After that he received his MDiv from Chesapeake Theological Seminary, and his ThD in historical theology from Grace Institute and Seminary. He now is a candidate for a PhD in systematic theology from Westminster Theological Seminary in Philadelphia.

MAJ Hartley has authored several publications, including a book called *Grace and Obedience* published in 2001. He also published his dissertation in 2005, and was an editor for Sound of Grace Publishing from 1997 to 2003.

No stranger to the military life, MAJ Hartley was an airman for the US Navy for 5 years. He enjoys playing ice hockey, reading and writing, and is a member of Grace Covenant Presbyterian Church in San Diego.

MAJ Hartley and his wife, Oneida, have four children, Jackie (24), Silas (18), Hannah (13) and Faith (11).
