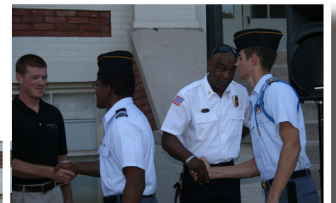


9/11 Ceremony

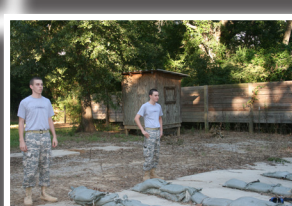
