The celebration will

begin with services at 10 a.m. at Oakland Chapel on the Alcorn State University campus in Lorman. Immediately following the service will be a fish fry under the Pavilion at Chamberlain-Hunt. The Academy's Cadets will perform a short pass-in-review drill on the parade deck following the dinner and before being released for the fall break.

Most of the Cadets are excited for the same reasons.

Chamberlain-Hunt has a long-lived tradition of changing the lives of young men. The Academy was established in 1879 and is the successor of Oakland College, a Presbyterian institution founded in 1830.

The Academy's name honors Dr. Jeremiah Chamberlain, the founder of Oakland College, and Mr. David Hunt, a benefactor who funded the College through his personally acquired wealth in the early 1800's.

Buz Lowry, director of development for the Academy says that this year Marty Fields, minister at Westminster Presbyterian Church in Laurel and chaplain in the Mississippi Air National Guard, will give the address. Fields, a native of Atlanta, is a graduate of Georgia Southern University and Reformed Theological Seminary.

The men's chorus of Alcorn State University will also be performing.
