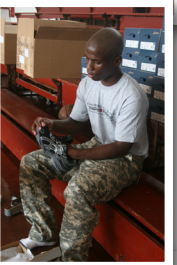
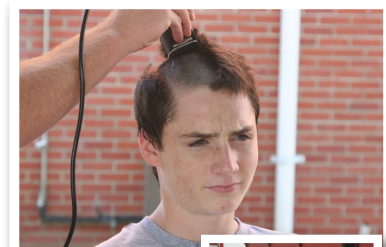

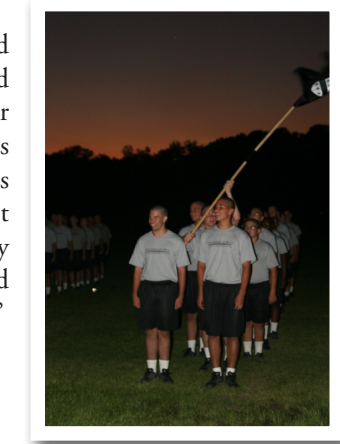


At the sound of reveille, a typical Basic Training morning began at 0400 with physical training, drills or a road march. After early morning activities concluded, Cadets ate a hearty breakfast in the DFAC to refuel for a full day of training events.

Cadets learned basic military skills such as marching and tactical skills. They were introduced to M-4 gun safety, how to make an emergency flotation device, dorm procedures and other regulations outlined in the Cadet Handbook. Cadets received their company assignments, and were also tested for academic placement and received their class schedules.

Basic training week concluded with an afternoon of paintball and a large bonfire and cookout.

The second week of the semester started with a devotional challenging Cadets and cadre "whether they eat or drink or whatever you do, do all to the glory of God." Cadets integrated their academic responsibilities into their schedules and completed their first week of classes with a Saturday School day that focused attention on Samuel Mason and the life-lesson "Actions have Consequences."
